Universal Design / Tier 1 Approach


School Health Assessment and Performance Evaluation (SHAPE) System

- Developed by National Center for School Mental Health (NCSMH)
 - Strengthen policies and programs in school mental health
 - Improve learning outcomes

SHAPE System Domains	Descriptions
Teaming	* Multidisciplinary staff; students, families, staff, and community partners.
Need Assessment / Resource Mapping	 Identify gaps and strengths. Visual representation of information. Share information about services + supports.
Screening	 Universal assessment. Systematic tool/process.
Tier 1- Promotion of Service + Supports	 Meets needs of ALL students. Includes: staff well-being, school climate, promotion of positive behavior.
Tier 2 + 3 Early Intervention	 Tier 2: Students identified or at risk. Tier 3: * Students experiencing significant distress and functional impairment.
Funding / Sustainability	 Optimizing financial and non-financial assets. Maintain/improve mental health systems over time.
Impact	• Long-term effects/change.
